Superintendent Recommendation for High School Options

After studying the possible high school options that Cayucos Elementary School District (CESD) may support, I am making this recommendation in order to support the following concepts.

- Parents' desire to have a secured choice of which high school they would like their student to attend.
- Tax revenue money needs to follow their student to the high school of their choice.

These two concepts are the fundamental underlying goals of the following recommendation.

1. CESD Board of Trustees to consider the attached resolution at the October Board meeting.
2. The resolution includes supporting the following goals in priority order.
 - a. **Priority 1:** Pursue unifying CESD into a K-12 district in order to enable parents to have a choice of which high school they want their children to attend without the fear that an inter-district attendance agreement for their student may be denied.
 - b. **Priority 2:** Pursue changing CESD from a component district of Coast Unified School District to a component district of San Luis Coastal Unified School District. This includes pursuing the component district change through either legislation or agreement.
 - c. **Priority 3:** Pursue a Memorandum of Understanding between Cayucos Elementary School District, Coast Unified School District and San Luis Coastal Unified School District that would allow students to attend either Coast Union High School or Morro Bay High School/San Luis Obispo High School with money following the student to the high school of their choice.
